Bethany Lutheran College Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program Student Outcomes Annual Report

Students in the CMHC Program are able to complete the master's program in either a two-year or a three-year plan of study. Student (FTE) to Faculty (FTE) was 8.49:1 during the 2022-23 academic year and full-time, core counselor education faculty taught 72% of all courses. The graduates in May of 2023 represent the first graduating cohort of the CMHC program. All seven of these graduates enrolled in the two-year plan of study and began the program in 2021. One hundred percent of the students graduated in the expected time.
