Requirements for application to the nursing major:

- Successful completion of admission requirements to Bethany Lutheran College (i.e. application, official transcripts).
- Sophomore standing eligibility (at least 28 credits) by end of semester of application.
- Current cumulative GPA of at least 2.75.
- Current enrollment in or successful completion ("C+" or higher) of NURS301 (Fundamentals of Nursing)
- Current enrollment in or successful completion (with a "C+" or higher) of the following prerequisite courses: BIOL 151* (General Biology 1) CHEM 107* (Gen/Organic/Biochem) or CHEM 113* (General Chemistry 1) BIOL 221* (Human Anatomy) ENGL 110 (College Writing)
 BIOL 222* (Human Physiology) ENGL 110 (College Writing)
 COMM 111 (Intro to Speech)
 PSYC 120 (Human Growth) *Science credits must be earned in the six years preceding progression into the major.

- Successful completion of the nursing major prerequisite courses with a minimum C+ grade
- Successful completion of a nursing assistant course or certification as a nursing assistant
- Approval to work with patients without supervision from the Minnesota Department of Human Services Background Study
- Submission of health clearance form with proof of required immunizations, medical insurance, and current CPR/BLS for health care providers
- Clear drug screen (if requested by Director of Nursing)
